Highlights from the August Board Meeting

- It was noted that there are no first aid kits readily available on the shooting ranges for use in an emergency. This will be corrected.
- A motion was made to purchase a car port style steel roof for the firing line on the 600 yard range to replace the canvas cover that needs replacing. Approved.
- A request was made to resume shooting bowling pins at wurtsmith. It was noted that this could be done with the construction of a safety eyebrow over the pins to contain ricochets.
